Beacon and The Salvation Army are in the process of partnering together to form the Center of Hope. The Center of Hope has been in the works for nearly 2 years. It will be housed in the basement of the Salvation Army on West Main. The center will be a place that the homeless can come during set hours to take advantage of showers, laundry facilities, a place to nap and grab a bite to eat. There will be assistance in finding agencies that can assist in breaking the chains of homelessness and despair.




