From Your Pastor...

Last Saturday was the **2019 Women's March**. Now in its third year, the March intends to address issues affecting women such as violence against women, immigrant rights, civil rights & liberties, and environmental justice.

Today, January 27, happens to be the day of commemoration for **three women of outstanding faith** we find in the New Testament.

Luke recorded that in the 40's **Lydia**, a merchant of expensive purple cloth, was a believer who offered her house in Thyatira (Turkey) in service to the Christian community, perhaps for worship purposes (Acts 16:14-15).

Luke also recorded that again, in the 40's, **Dorcas**, also named Tabitha, a resident of Joppa (in Israel), was beloved for her assistance to the poor. When she died, Peter restored her to life (Acts 9:36-43).

In the mid-50's, Paul wrote commending the work of **Phoebe** (Romans 16:1). She is praised as a benefactor of the Christian mission in Cenchreae (Greece). Paul calls her a "deacon," which title has occasioned much discussion about what role she played and what were her responsibilities in the church.

These three women represent three different Christian ministries: Lydia, a woman of wealth, was known for her hospitality; Dorcas was dedicated to care for the poor; and Phoebe had a leadership position in the church in Greece. Their names can stand for many other women who served as faithful witnesses to the faith.


Weekly Health Tip! When traveling where water cleanliness is questionable, pack hand gel or hand sanitizer for an easy way to clean hands before meals.
