Monthly Health Note: Hypertension, Part 1

May is Hypertension month. Hypertension, or high blood pressure, is a condition where the force of blood against the artery walls is consistently too high. It often develops silently, without noticeable symptoms, but over time, it can lead to serious health complications like heart disease, stroke, and kidney damage. The normal blood pressure reading is 120/80 or lower. It's measured in millimeters of mercury (mmHg) and consists of two numbers:

- **Systolic pressure**: The top number represents the pressure when your heart contracts and pushes blood out.
- **Diastolic pressure**: The bottom number indicates the pressure when your heart is at rest between beats.

There are two types of hypertension: The first is Primary Hypertension, which develops quietly over time due to lifestyle choices, environment, and aging. The second type is Secondary Hypertension, which is caused by other underlying medical conditions such as diabetes, kidney disease, and some medications.

Common risk factors for hypertension are: high salt intake, smoking, obesity, lack of physical activity, stress, and age greater than 50.

Many people with high blood pressure have no noticeable symptoms. If symptoms of hypertension do appear, they are severe headaches, shortness of breath, nosebleeds, ringing in the ears, fatigue, blurred vision, dizziness, and anxiety. If you experience any of these symptoms and they are severe or sudden, it is important to see a doctor to have your BP checked and to determine the cause of your symptoms. *NEXT*: Treatment for Hypertension
