Initial Return to Worship

The first phase of an initial return to in-person worship begins on **Tuesday**, **July 7 at 9:00AM** and continues on each subsequent **Tuesday in July** with a brief service of Holy Communion offered outside in the courtyard (weather permitting, or in the chapel) for a gathering of **no more than 10 people** (including pastor). Attendance is by **reservation only** and **priority** will be given to those **members who do not have easy access to a computer** and have been unable to participate in online worship. Since this service is *primarily* for these members, those identified as in this group will have a **standing reservation**, so they don't have to worry about calling to reserve a spot each week.

At the moment, these parameters leave space for **four additional members to attend**. Please **email Pastor Brian** (pastor@stmarkbelleville.org) if you are interested in reserving spaces for any of the Tuesdays in July. This will be "**first come, first served**," and he asks for the time being that you only request one Tuesday so as to allow an opportunity for more members to attend. If demand is high, a Thursday morning service may be added as well.

All attendees should expect the following:

- The wearing of cloth face coverings/masks is required
- Communion will be served in the form of prepackaged bread wafer and grape juice
- **Physical distancing** will be maintained, although members who live together and/or who traveled together to worship may sit together.
- A stationary collection box will be in place to collect offerings
- There will be no physical sharing of the peace, greeting line, or formal time of fellowship.
 Members are welcome to visit with each other from an appropriate distance.
- Attendees who are able are invited to bring their own chairs. Stackable plastic chairs will be provided for those who cannot/do not wish to bring their own. These are easy to both move and to sanitize after the service.
- Hand sanitizer will be available and its use will be encouraged by attendees upon arrival
 and before departing.
- Of course, please stay home if you are showing any signs or symptoms associated with COVID-19.
 - *Please note that online worship will continue even after these services begin.


Sing Out Loud, Sing Out Strong!
